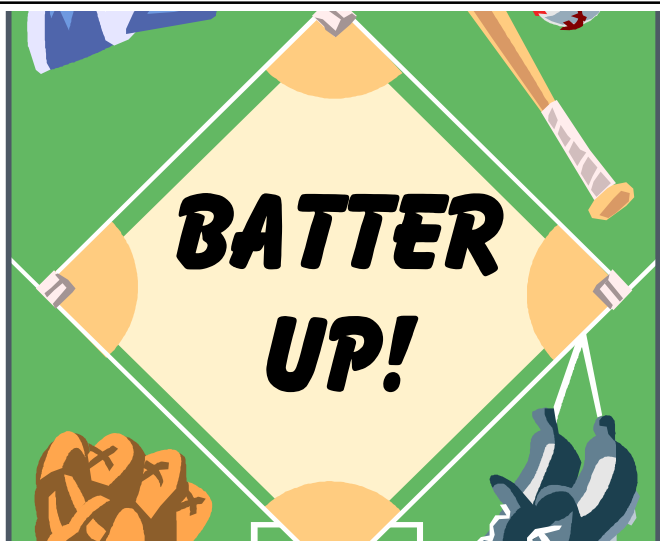


Computer Lab

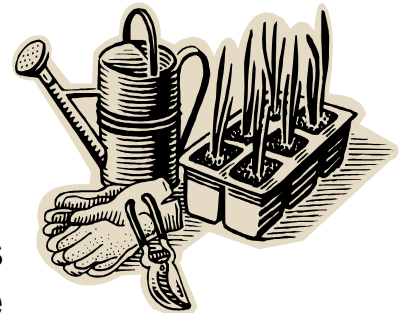

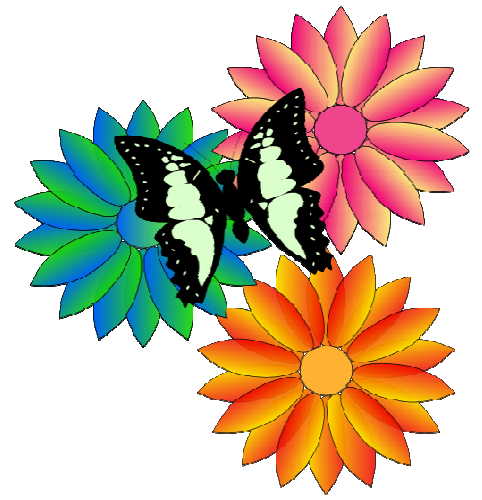

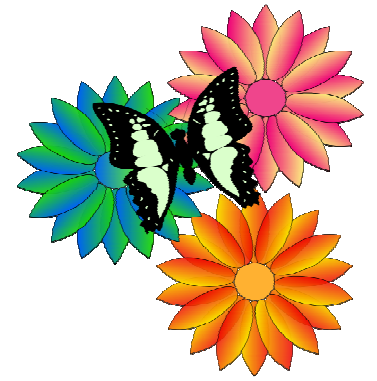
