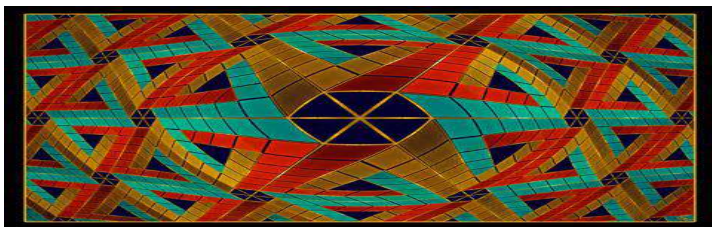

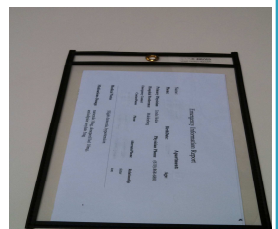

Your emergency information sheet should be in a **plastic sleeve by your water heater**. If you do not have one please let me know. That is where the paramedics know to find it.



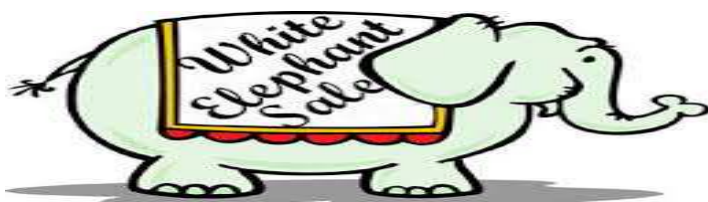

SONDHEIM: A BIRTHDAY CONCERT AT LINCOLN CENTER: DVD

On Thursday morning, May 15th at 10 am we invite you to gather in the Lounge here at Lutheran Manor for excerpts from **SONDHEIM: A BIRTHDAY CONCERT.**

Stephen Sondheim has for more than 40 years, enriched the theatre, films, and television. He wrote the lyrics for *West Side Story* (1957) and then took on the formidable task of writing both music and lyrics for a musical based on the life of Gypsy Rose Lee (premiered in New York City in 1959). He wrote music and lyrics for another successful musical, "*Company*" which ran for more than 700 performances and has been revived several times since 1970.



His music is complex, rousing, joyful- but never dull! "*Follies*," "*A Little Night Music*," "*Pacific Overtures*," "*Sweeney Todd*," "*Into the Woods*," "*Sunday in the Park with George*," and "*Assassins*" have helped to create his legacy to the creative world of musical theatre.

In the year of his 80th birthday, a public celebration was held at Lincoln Centre, New York City. With the New York philharmonic and a stage full of stars, it was an unforgettable evening. A wonderful DVD from Lincoln Centre affords us the opportunity to join "Steve" in his well-earned tribute. *Sponsored by the Chat Room*

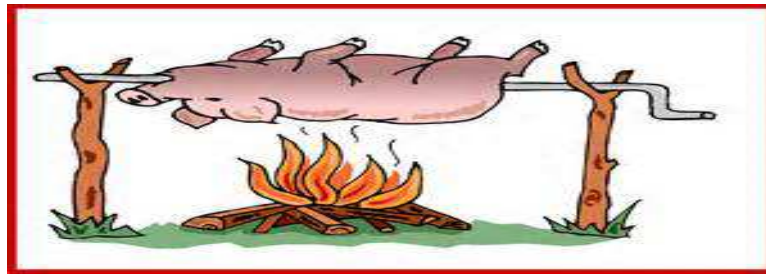

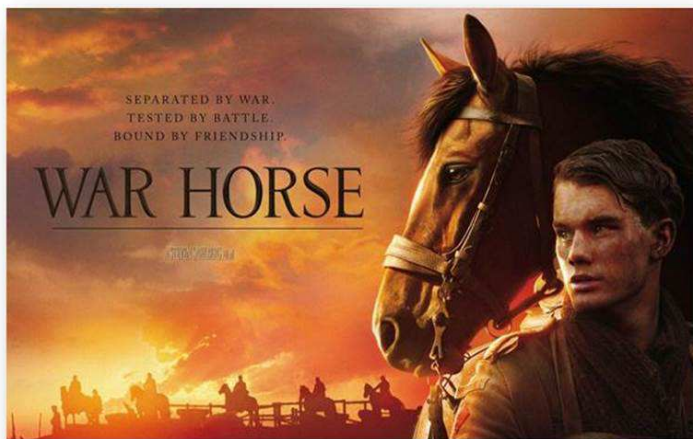
