Stephen Sondheim has for more than 40 years, enriched the theatre, films, and television. He wrote music and lyrics for another successful musical, "Company" which ran for more than 700 performances and has been revived several times since 1970.

His music is complex, rousing, joyful- but never dull! "Follies," "A Little Night Music," "Pacific Overtures," "Sweeney Todd," "Into the Woods," "Sunday in the Park with George," and "Assassins" have helped to create his legacy to the creative world of musical theatre.

In the year of his 80th birthday, a public celebration was held at Lincoln Centre, New York City. With the New York philharmonic and a stage full of stars, it was an unforgettable evening. 
