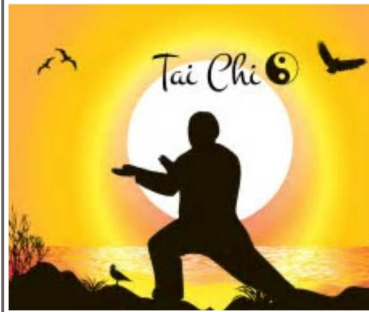

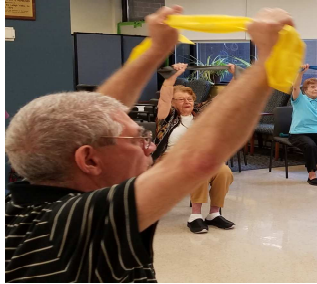

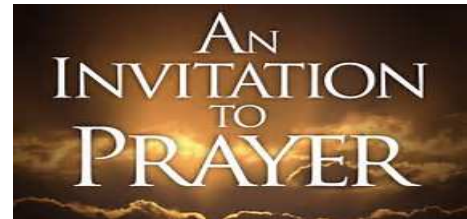

“Welcome to Bethlehem, The Christmas City”.

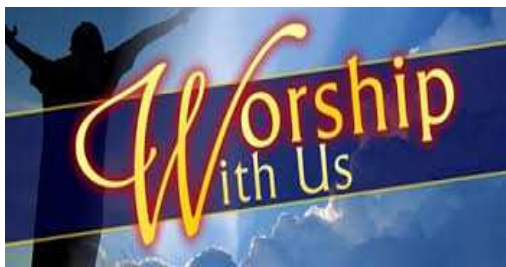
Traditionally, candles are lit the first Sunday in Advent. So, please **light your candles** on **Sunday, November 26** and enjoy the holidays.

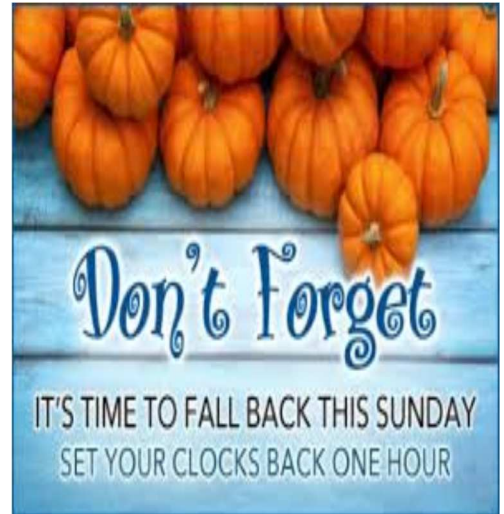

STONE SOUP....*an old folk tale.*

Some travelers come to a village, carrying nothing more than an empty cooking pot. Upon their arrival, the villagers are unwilling to share any of their food with the hungry travelers. Then the travelers go to a stream and fill the pot with water, drop a large stone in it, and place it over a fire. One of the villagers becomes curious and asks what they are doing. The travelers answer that they are making "stone soup", which tastes wonderful and which they would be delighted to share with the villager, although it still needs a little bit of garnish, which they are missing, to improve the flavor. The villager, who anticipates enjoying a share of the soup, does not mind parting with a few carrots, so these are added to the soup. Another villager walks by, inquiring about the pot, and so it goes. More and more villagers walk by, each adding another ingredient. Finally, the stone (being inedible) is removed from the pot, and a delicious pot of soup is enjoyed by travelers and villagers alike. The travelers have successfully transformed stone soup into a tasty and nutritious meal which they share with the donors.

The story of "Stone Soup" pointedly shows us the beauty of "community" and "sharing"--- values strongly urged by Jesus Christ himself. Before we "indulge" in the wealth of our own goodness this month, let us stop and remember all the blessings God has so richly showered upon us. Let us, too, open our hearts and eyes to the possibilities of sharing those blessings with others---whether it is through our time, skills, smiles, offerings, warmth or compassion.

Frank Sinatra - The Main Event at Madison Square Garden (DVD)

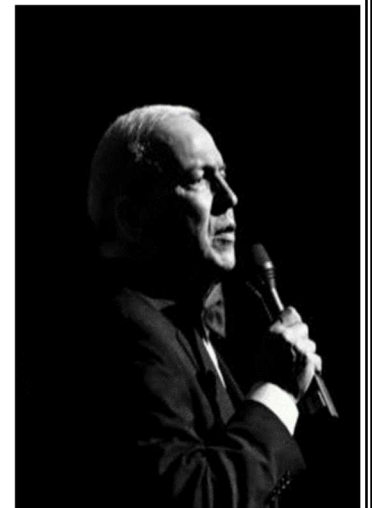

A sports arena is hardly the ideal setting for the Chairman of the Board--he's forced to shush the massive crowd before he can attempt the intimate "Angel Eyes"--but by the same token he has this keyed-up audience dancing in the aisles to his brassy rendition of "Bad, Bad Leroy Brown."
