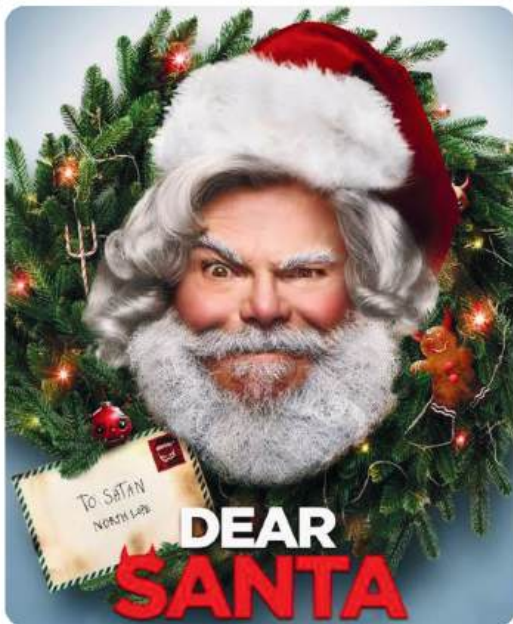

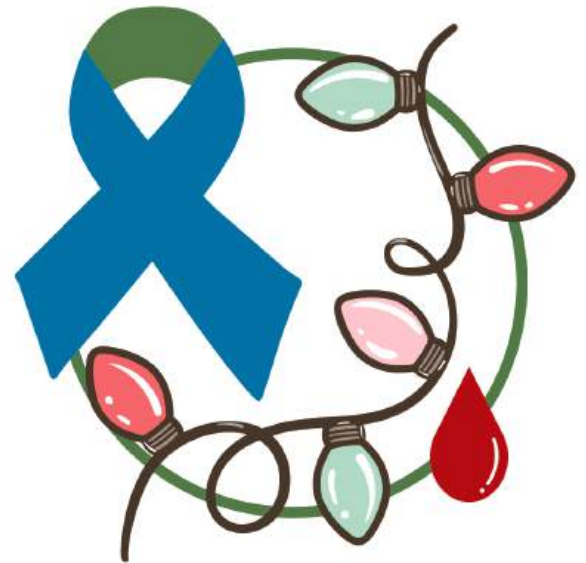

Choose ONE dessert you really love, then savor a small serving



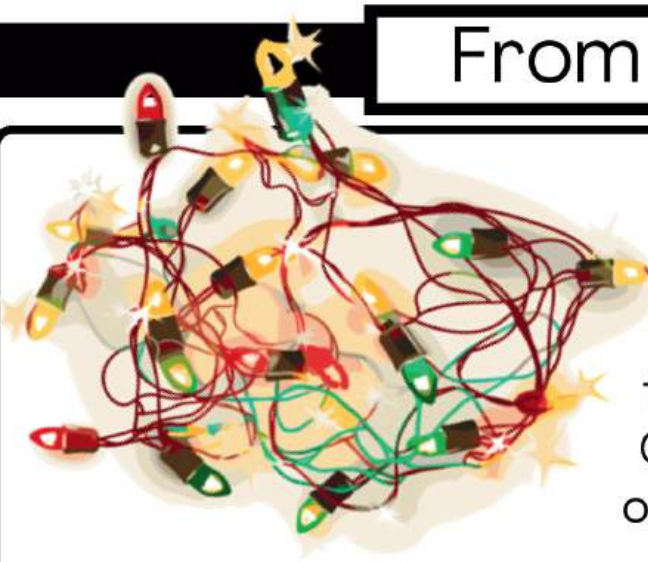
Fill a small plate with your favorite foods, then leave the buffet table

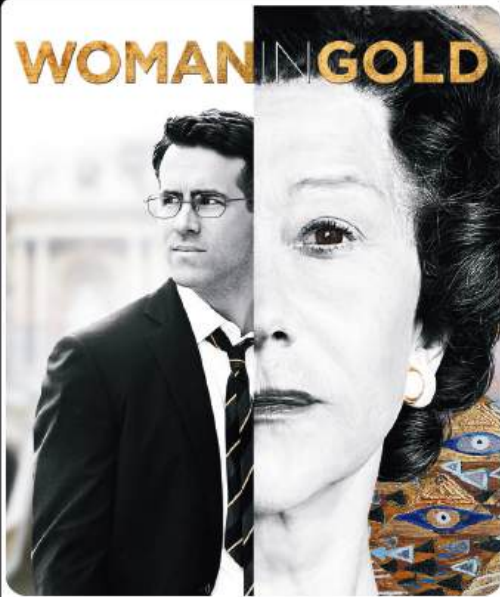

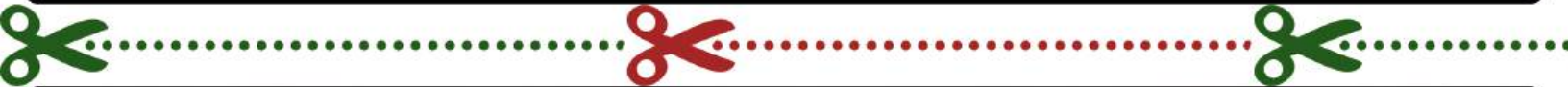

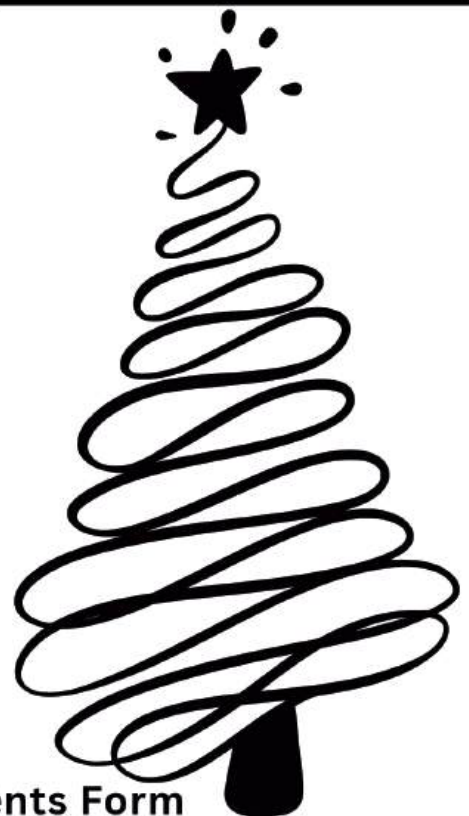
