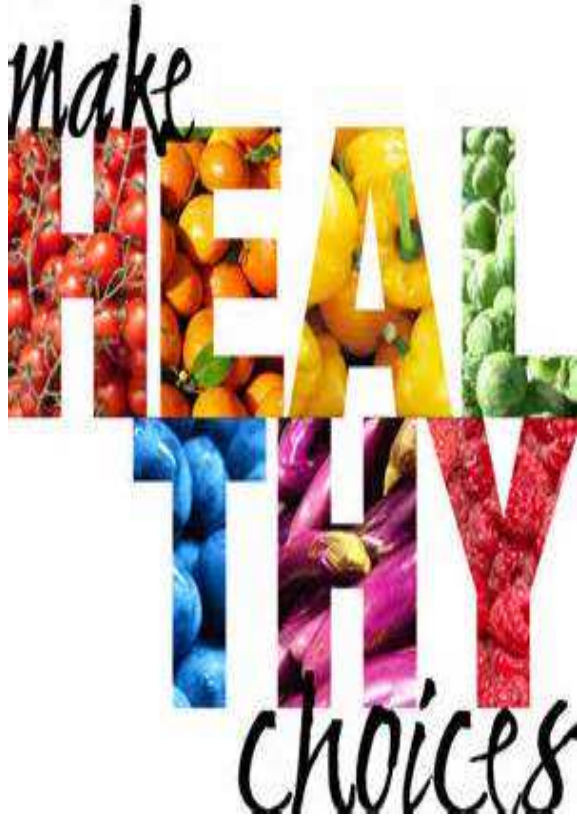

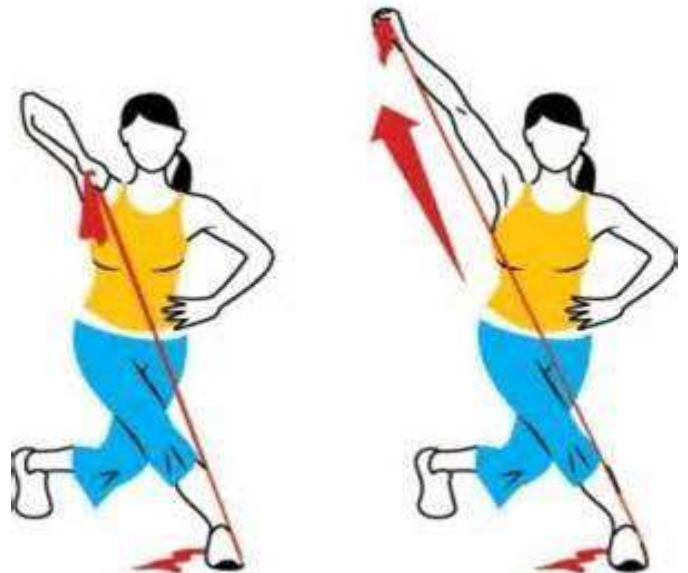

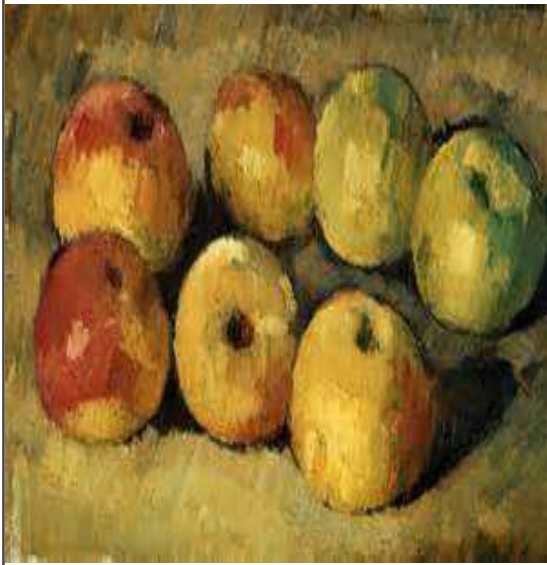

Due to our tight schedule the maintenance department will start their inspections at 8:30 AM on:

You do **NOT** have to do anything for this inspection.

You do not have to be home, but if you are not home on these days, maintenance will enter your apartment and do their inspection.

Note from the Manager...

I hope everyone had a joyous & safe holiday!! The Lutheran Manor staff received so many wonderful greeting cards, gifts, and delicious baked goods. I personally would like to thank everyone for their generosity this holiday season- THANK YOU!!! As always, it is our pleasure to continue working hard and ensuring that Lutheran Manor is the best senior community in the valley!

During the last Tenants Association Meeting, I announced that we will be replacing our medical duress system at Lutheran Manor. This is the medical call system that is triggered when *you pull your emergency cord* in your apartment. This system will be replaced in the beginning of **FEBRUARY**. During the installation period, there will be one week that your emergency cord WILL NOT WORK. We will notify you the exact dates that it will be shut down. (*closer to February*) These dates will be posted on the bulletin boards and the TV message boards located on each floor, as well as a memo delivered to your apartment. During the time this system will be shut down, you will need to call 911 directly yourself if you are in an emergency situation. Thank you for your cooperation.

Another one of our efforts to keep Lutheran Manor in superior condition is *Preventive Maintenance*. One aspect of this goal is our bi-annual apartment inspections. In January, we will be inspecting all apartments in the building. Please be sure to report any maintenance problems or concerns to our staff during your inspection. We can only address or resolve maintenance issues if we know about them. In addition, we have a new preventative contract with our pest control company. We are going to add preventative inspections to all apartments and common areas, as well as home inspections to scheduled move-in's. If there is an unwanted pest or critter at Lutheran Manor, we want to find it! We have improved our preventive maintenance contract with our elevator company. We know unexpected maintenance issues happen with elevators, but we are dedicated to keep those situations to a minimum.

Please continue to report any problems in your apartment or around the building, and we will be sure to address it!! 2014 was a great year at Lutheran Manor, but **2015** is going to be bigger and better yet!!!

More André Rieu!! On January 15th we will once again be entertained by this outstanding Dutch violinist and conductor best known for creating the waltz-playing Johann Struss Orchestra.

This is a 2007 mid-summer concert which took place in front of imperial Hofburg Palace in the center of Vienna. Playlist selection is wonderful with 25 classical hits. There are waltzes, polkas, arias and musical pieces. The highlights are All Strauss Waltzes, Eine kleine Nachtmusik (Mozart Medley), The Sound of Music, and Arias.

The Johann Strauss Orchestra is accompanied by Choir and joined by guest stars namely The Platine Tenors, Dogmar Koller, Carmen Monarcha, Carla Maffioletti, Mirusia Louwerse and Suzan Erens.
