I was thinking about how the early disciples did not immediately recognize the Lord after His resurrection (see Luke 24:13-32; John 20:11-1; 21:4-7). It's a call to pay attention. When we don't expect him, when we don't look for him, when

don't have eyes to see him, we don't see Jesus.

Mother Teresa once said, "I see Jesus in every human being. I say to myself, this is hungry Jesus, I must feed him. This is sick Jesus. This one has leprosy or gangrene; I must wash him and tend to him."
